How can I be trained by one?

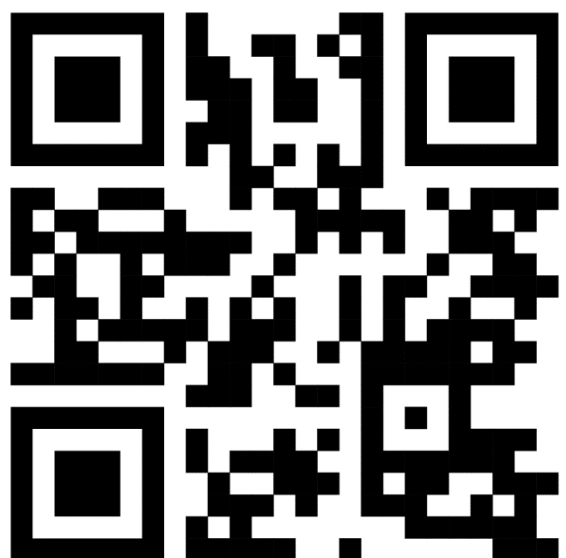
